
#### CHALLENGE YOURSELF

## Online admission process

- Registration of the APPLICATION FILE through admitere.ase.ro (20th-22nd of July, on 22nd until 16:00)

  Documents required for registration are differentiated based on student origin, a complete list being available at imba fabiz ase ro/admission (see OR code below).
- Publication of the schedule for the language competence interview (22nd of July)
- ONLINE English language competence assessment INTERVIEW & results (23rd of July)

An eliminatory interview for assessing the English language proficiency will be organized for all students that did not graduate from a bachelor degree fully taught in English, or do not have a B2 or higher on one of the following certifications: FCE, CAE, CPE, BEC Vantage, BEC Higher, or IELTS (minimum Band 6.0), BULATS (minimum 60). TOEFL (minimum 87).

- Publication of the schedule for the admission exam (23rd of July)
- 3 ONLINE ADMISSION EXAM & results (24th of July)

  The exam has a multiple-choice format and is graded electronically. The final grade should be higher than 6.00 and is based on the following formula: final grade = 40% exam + 60% bachelor graduation grade. The bibliography for the admission exam, as well as the one for the English language assessment interview are

- Publication of the preliminary admission results (27th of July)
- Place confirmation (27th-29th of July, 9:00-16:00)
  Places financed from the state budget are confirmed through admitere.ase.ro by submitting an affidavit on the candidate's comitment to bring the original baccalaureate and bachelor diplomas for the original

The confirmation of places WITH fee is done by the payment of ½ of the yearly tuition fee through admitere.ase.ro or bank transfer. Registration of withdrawals is also done during this period through admitere.ase.ro

- Final results (3rd of August)
- Academic year start (1st of October) and signing of tuition contracts and original documents submission (28th of September - 16th of October)
